We have the potential of reaching at least 4,000 children in Zambia by December. Paul Mamba in Tanzania is responsible for reaching about 6,000 children in his country. He is spreading the vision there to raise a generation of world changers. New doors have





opened in India with the potential of impacting hundreds of thousands of children. The Lord is so good. Many international leaders have gone through our training.

Budget for Three Projects in Zambia—\$6,260

1. Devotional books are needed for Lundazi (1580), Chipapa (36), and Mwandu (17). The total cost is \$5,080.
2. L.I.T. sponsored a mission trip in Zambia with 120 children in October. The cost to fund the trip and materials is \$600.
3. Our next upcoming training event in Zambia for 100 leaders is \$780.
